

Service of Testing Order

WHAT ...

“Testing Order” means an order made by the Provincial Court that directs the Chief Medical Officer of Health to search the communicable disease databases or that directs a source individual to allow a qualified health professional to take a sample of a bodily substance from the source individual for analysis, or both (*Section 1(q) Mandatory Testing and Disclosure Act*).

WHO ...

Section 4(6) of the *Mandatory Testing and Disclosure Act* requires that “The applicant must serve a copy of the testing order on the Chief Medical Officer of Health and provide the Chief Medical Officer of Health with a copy of the physician’s report.”
